Ray Burkart plays Lakeview Country Club in Harrisonburg, Virginia with his caddie "Big Red." He made a special adapter for a **6-foot-diameter beach umbrella**, and though he doesn't use it in strong winds, on hot Virginia days he gets lots of admiring looks, and occasionally for a lark he'll call out "Hot Dogs, Hamburgers, Cold Beer!" Ray's bright idea is to counterweight the rig (using a heavy fluorescent light ballast) in his golf bag front pocket. He fabricated an extra-long tube above the **umbrella mount that's standard on the Hillcrest X-series scorecard handle.**

A Kangaroo is a terrible thing to waste

If you know any golfer who no longer can use a Kangaroo Hillcrest or Model 5, the factory has a **consignment program** to find a new Owner for it.
