CaddyCell Lithium Battery Instructions

All CaddyCell batteries are made of high quality Lithium Ferro-Phosphate cells. Safest, most stable battery available for your Kangaroo. One-year warranty.*

Please follow these instructions to get the most out of your CaddyCell battery.



Charging

- 1. Attach charger cable to charger port located on side facing negative terminal.
- 2. Attach power cable to charger. Plug into wall socket.
- 3. Red light on charger indicates battery is charging. Green light indicates battery is fully charged.





Operation



Hooking up battery:

- 1. Attach battery wiring harness to chassis power port on your Kangaroo, lining red to red and black to black.
- 2. Attach "t-bar" to terminals on CaddyCell battery, lining positive to positive and negative to negative.

Removing Battery

Detach "t-bar" from battery terminals. Battery wiring harness can be left in place if you prefer.

USB Port (on 16 amp-hour size)

USB port is located on the side of battery facing positive terminal. Simply lift velcro cover to attach USB cable for charging your electronic device.

Safety

- Always ensure charger or motorcaddie connections are fully connected to the battery.
- Don't position charger plug in a way that will cause any strain on the plug or wire.
- When charger isn't in use, ensure it is unplugged from the wall outlet AND battery. This prevents damage in case of a power-surge.
- Per airline safety regulations, do not transport battery by air. Can be transported in the trunk of a car, but do not store there for extended periods.
- Recharge immediately after every round, even when you've played fewer than 18 holes.
- Okay to leave battery on after recharging is complete, but don't leave charging indefinitely. Remains ready for 18 holes up to 12 weeks.

*CaddyCell lithium battery is rain safe but cannot be fully immersed in water. If it is fully immersed the warranty will be voided.
